

Art 1 Course Syllabus

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Course Description

Art 1 is for students with little or no previous art experience and is a prerequisite for all other high school art courses. Students will explore the art elements of line, shape, value, color, texture, form and space. Students will also learn to apply the principles of art in developing and creating original artworks using a variety of media and techniques.

Course Objective

- By the end of the course, students will have the knowledge of basic media, techniques and careers in art and art history.
- Understand how the art elements are design principles communicate content.

Face to Face Supplies

For the first three weeks, you will not need any art supplies other than a device. Once in class, students will be provided with a supply kit that will not be used by any other student. Due to the uncertain nature of the year, it might be handy to bring it home each day (in case of a shut down). The supply fee for Art 1 is \$40 and can be paid via cash, MySchoolBucks or check (made payable to SCHS).

AVL Supplies

In order to be able to complete art assignments, students will need some specific supplies. You are welcome to acquire them in any manner that works for you but to make life easier I've provided an [Amazon shopping list](#).

Face to Face Attendance

In order for students to keep up with deadlines, they are expected to attend and work proficiently in class everyday. If class is missed, it is the student's duty to make up projects outside of normal class time. Students are required to have their project and supplies with them everyday.

AVL Attendance

Students are required to submit each day's assignment before 11:59PM in order to be considered present.

Grading Policy

All assignments will be posted and turned in to Google Classroom. Check for new assignments each day. Students will earn at least 1 major grade per 3-week period for the major projects completed. At least one daily grade will be assigned per week from class participation, cleanup, critiques, studio time, sketchbooks, quizzes and class assignments.

Turning in an assignment late will result in a 10 point deduction per day for the first 3 days. After the 3rd day, students will automatically receive a zero.

Classroom Rules

- Be on time with supplies accessible and ready to work.
- Respect your materials, classmates and teacher.
- Students must sit at their assigned seat everyday and stay seated
- No food or drinks (other than a closed water bottle)
- All electronic devices will only be used with teacher's permission for educational purposes.
