Course Description

This course is designed to allow students to explore and understand creative techniques within the drawing medium. Students will use observation, and their imagination and knowledge to create dynamic compositions while comparing and learning about different materials and themes. While working on a professional portfolio, students will begin to understand creative style and define their own. Critiques will be administered in which students will love the artwork of their peers and to artists of the past for similarities and differences.

Course Objective

- Develop a higher level in concept, composition and execution of artwork using a variety of mediums and techniques.
- Develop an understanding of art as an ongoing process.
- Understand how the art element and design principles communicate content

Face to Face Supplies

For the first three weeks, you only need a pencil and paper. Once in class, students will be provided with a supply kit that will not be used by any other student. Due to the uncertain nature of the year, it might be handy to bring it home each day (in case of a shut down). The supply fee for Drawing is \$60 and can be paid via cash, MySchoolBucks or check (made payable to SCHS).

AVL Supplies

Students will be required to pick up supplies from Shadow Creek High School. When this is scheduled, families will be notified via Skyward. The supply fee for Drawing is \$60 and can be paid via cash, MySchoolBucks or check (made payable to SCHS). The fee must be paid before supplies can be picked up.

Face to Face Attendance

In order for students to keep up with deadlines, they are expected to attend and work proficiently in class everyday. If class is missed, it is the student's duty to make up projects outside of normal class time. Students are required to have their project and supplies with them everyday.

AVL Attendance

Students are required to submit each day's assignment before 11:59PM in order to be considered present.

Grading Policy

All assignments will be posted and turned in to Google Classroom. Check for new assignments each day. Students will earn at least 1 major grade per 3-week period for the major projects

completed. At least one daily grade will be assigned per week from class participation, cleanup, critiques, studio time, sketchbooks, quizzes and class assignments.

Turning in an assignment late will result in a 10 point deduction per day for the first 3 days. After the 3rd day, students will automatically receive a zero.

Classroom Rules

- Be on time with supplies accessible and ready to work.
- Respect your materials, classmates and teacher.
- Students must sit at their assigned seat everyday and stay seated
- No food or drinks (other than a closed water bottle)
- All electronic devices will only be used with teacher's permission for educational purposes.
